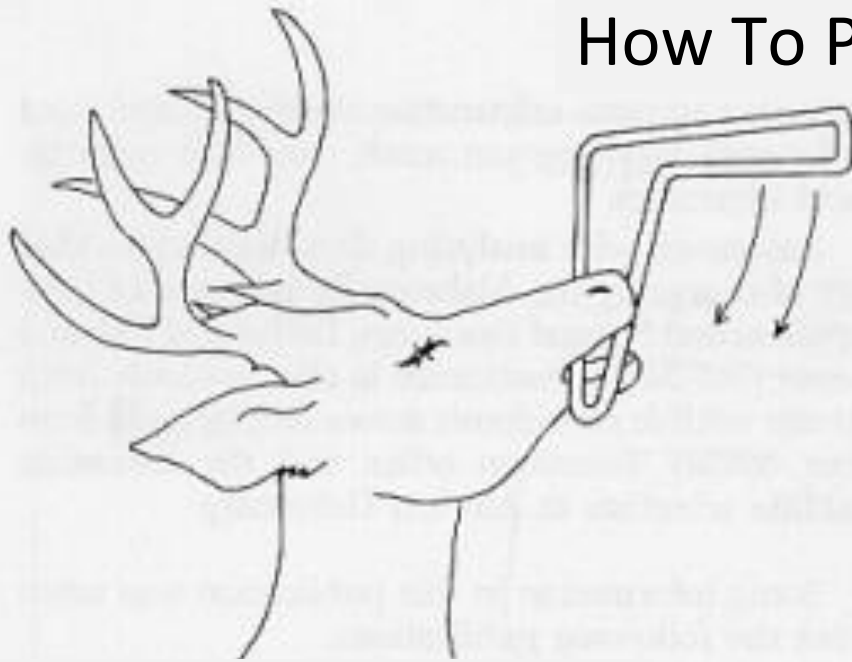
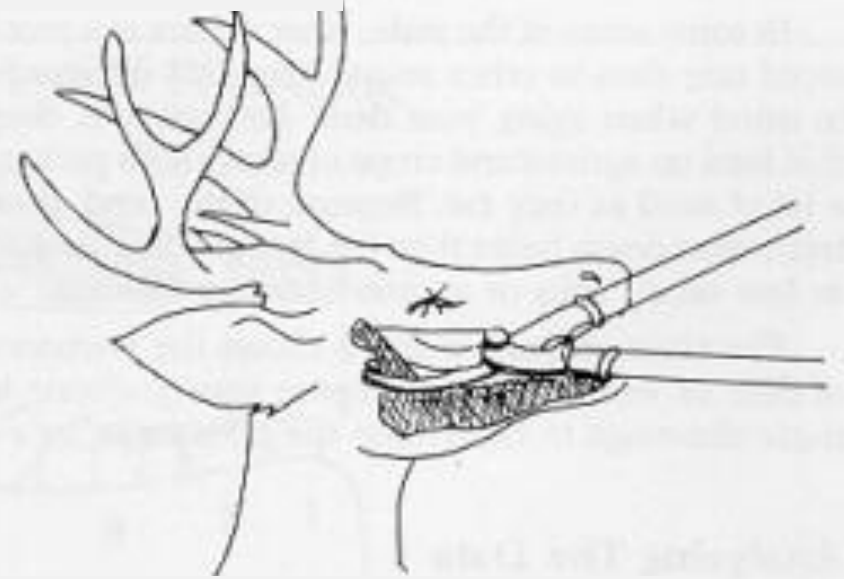


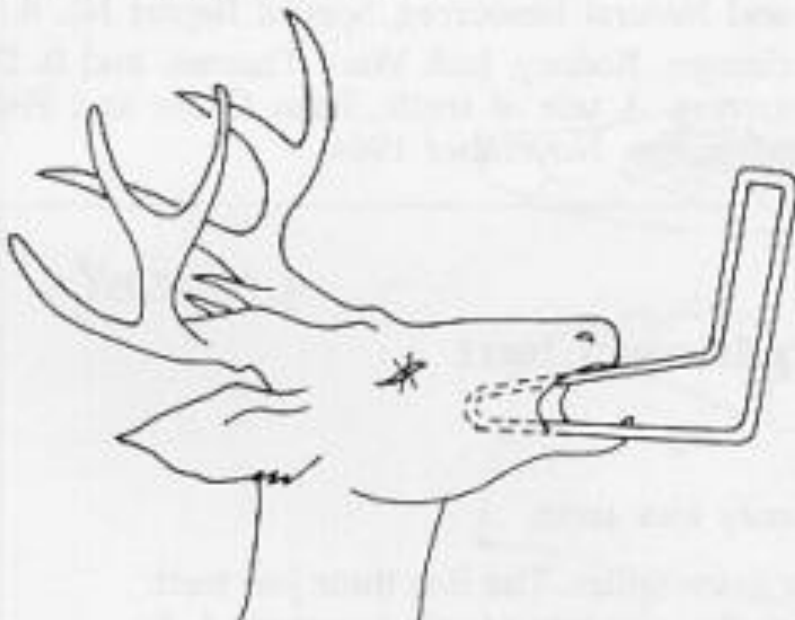
How To Pull A Jawbone



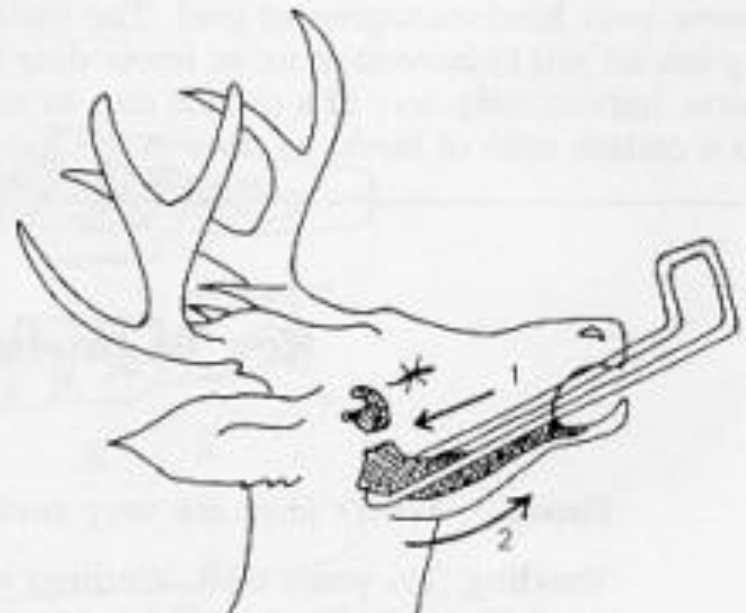
Step 1. Pry the mouth open



Step 3. Carefully cut the jawbone.



Step 2. Loosen the muscles between the jawbone and the cheek.



Step 4. Slip the puller around the end of the jawbone and pull forward.

Instructions for Submitting Deer Jawbones*

1. Remove one side of the lower jawbone from your deer **according to the instructions on the poster.**
2. With a knife, remove as much of the excess tissue as possible from the jawbone.
3. Fill out one of the tags with the following information: (see example)
 - a. Hunter's full name
 - b. Date of Harvest
 - c. Sex of Deer
 - d. Weight of Deer (indicate whether dressed or live weight)
 - e. Training Area of Harvest
4. Attach the tag firmly to jawbone using the wires.
5. Place the tagged jawbone inside the wire collection bin.
